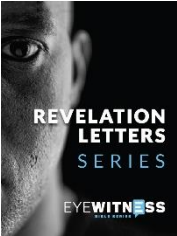


CURRENT

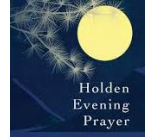
